General Information

Scheduling your Scout Program

All programs must be scheduled in advance by calling the Concord Museum at 978-369-9763. Programs can be scheduled for weekdays and Saturdays, on a space available basis. To secure your troop's tour or program, a non-refundable \$50 deposit is required and must be received two weeks prior to the scheduled program date.

Pre-Arrival Information

In order to have the correct amount of supplies and adequate staff, please report any changes in number of participants at least 2 days prior to the schedule date. Significant increases or decreases in numbers must be communicated no less than one week in advance. Chaperones necessary for transportation are admitted free; additional chaperones pay the same Scout program rate. (Not applicable during Family Trees.) When possible, Scouts should arrive with nametags.

During your Scout Program

Snacks are not provided but snack-time and space can be provided if necessary.

Post-Program

Girl Scout Troop leaders are responsible for securing and distributing earned badges. Boy Scout leaders are responsible for securing and distributing any earned Belt Loops and Badges.
